### **Did you know?**

Young children with developed rhythm skills perform better academically in early school years. Findings of a recent study showed that there was a significant difference in the academic achievement levels of students classified according to rhythmic competency. Students who were achieving at academic expectations scored high on all rhythmic tasks, while many of those who scored lower on the rhythmic test achieved below academic expectation.

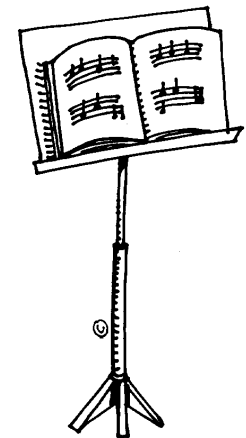


Dear Guests,
